We are seeking a Subject Lead for Religious Studies. The Religious Studies department has one main teacher who is the Subject Lead and he/she is supported by a member of staff who also teaches Geography. For GCSE, the Department follows the Pearson IGCSE specification (4RS1) and at A Level, we follow the OCR specification (H573). However, we are open to the new subject lead choosing the exam board they prefer. We teach a broad academic range and are required to stretch the very bright, as well as nurture those pupils who need support. In terms of the age range of our pupils, we teach from Year 7 to GCE A Level.

As a member of our team, you will be expected to uphold and promote the School's ethos and reputation, both within the community and beyond, consistently demonstrating the highest professional standards. You will also be expected to commit to the life of our busy boarding school, carrying out academic, pastoral and boarding duties with professionalism and as instructed by the Head.
